The State Aid increase was almost entirely School Choice Aid. The remaining amount listed as "Other State Aids" consists of Per-Pupil Growth Aid of \$13,740 and PARCC Readiness Aid of \$13,740.



With this unanticipated increase in State Aid of \$414,580 for 2014-2015, District Administration conducted an intensive review of the budget and proposes the following items seen on the next few slides.

The Board can adjust these proposals as deemed appropriate prior to the Public Hearing on April 30, 2014.
