Voting begins on the NJS GC's New Jersey Top Ten beaches web site at njtopenbeaches.org in February and continues through the end of April. The results of the survey are announced each year just before Memorial Day weekend at the NJS GC's *State of the Shore* Media Event, which brings together coastal experts, State officials, and members of the news media to kick off the summer season at the Jersey Shore.
