High School Elective Proposal

World Language Department: Latin

Current Status: The Latin program includes Latin I, II, and III (Advanced) and Latin IV (Honors)

Proposal: Addition of Honors Latin III

Rationale:

- ▶ To provide the students an opportunity to continue with a 3rd year of Latin with an accelerated curriculum and course weight and to work towards fluency and proficiency in this language.
- ▶ To mirror the set-up of other World Language offerings.
- ▶ To prepare students to participate in the competitive National Latin Exam.
- ▶ Increase opportunities for Seal of Biliteracy
- ▶ **Costs:** \$250 for materials and supplies.

High School Textbook Proposal

World Language Department: Spanish 2

Current Status: Spanish 1 was completed in 2014-15, Spanish 2 is up next in the sequence

Proposal: To purchase the textbook, *Realidades*, for Spanish II courses (all levels).

Rationale:

- ▶ To provide cultural information and current vocabulary with a focus on student engagement via new textbooks.
 - ▶ To align to updated core content standards in World Language and support the Level I Spanish program.
 - ▶ To incorporate technology into the program including 21st century college and career skills.
- ▶ **Costs:** Instructional supplies & text series - \$18,400

Intermediate School Textbook

World Language Department: Grades 6-8

Current Status: The current series no longer lines up with Spanish I textbooks at the High School.

▶ **Proposal:** To purchase textbook, *Realidades, Level I* for Spanish courses, grades 6, 7, and 8.

Rationale:

- ▶ To provide cultural information and current vocabulary with a focus on student engagement via new textbooks.
 - ▶ To align to updated core content standards in World Language and prepare students for High School Spanish.
 - ▶ To incorporate technology into the program including 21st century college and career skills.
- ▶ **Costs:** Instructional supplies & text series - \$4,500

High School New Textbook

Physical Education Department: Sports Medicine

Current Status: The Health and Physical Education Department is seeking to support this popular elective with a textbook.

Proposal: Incorporate the textbook *Basic Athletic Training*, 6th edition, along with ancillary materials.

Rationale:

- ▶ To address topics of current philosophies, emergency first aid, procedures and practices related to the care and prevention of athletic injuries.
- ▶ To provide students with knowledge and skills in dealing with personal sports injuries.
- ▶ To provide videos and materials for students to view dynamic aspects of anatomy and physiology and to analyze and treat common injuries.
- ▶ **Costs:**
 - ▶ Equipment and supplies = \$1640.

High School Textbook Proposal

Science Department: AP Physics

Current Status: ETS/College Board revised and changed the AP Physics scope and sequence.

Proposal: To purchase *College Physics AP Physics Edition* textbook with *Mastering Physics e Text*.

Rationale:

- ▶ To meet the required College Board text requirements for this course.
- ▶ To meet the State Standards for Science
- ▶ To prepare our students for the updated AP exams
- ▶ **Costs:** Textbook and ancillary materials- \$9,055

Intermediate School Textbook

Social Studies Department: Grade 7

Current Status: The current program is over 15 years old

Proposal: To purchase the textbook, *Building Citizenship: Civics and Economics* for the 7th grade Social Studies program.

Rationale:

- ▶ Focus on the big ideas with content built around Essential Questions and the National Civics and Economics Standards
 - ▶ Make concepts real and relevant with The Story Matters chapter openers, Teen Citizens in Action, Landmark Supreme Court Cases and service learning activities
 - ▶ Maximize comprehension with built-in reading strategies and vocabulary support
 - ▶ Build critical thinking skills with You Decide, Being an Active Citizen, Why It Matters, and 21st Century Skill Activities
- ▶ **Costs:** Instructional supplies & text series - \$7,374
